## Installation:

-From your base Magento2 directory -> app -> code (you may have to create this directory), create Sunflowerbiz directory to your app/code directory.

-From the base Magento2 directory, upload the contents of 'ChinaAddress' directory to 'app/code' directory of your Magento installation

-Enable the module running the following commands on the root of your Magento installation:

```
bin/magento module:enable --clear-static-content Sunflowerbiz_ChinaAddress
```

```
bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```

The following commands should work even in windows with the forward slash swapped for back.

```
php bin/magento cache:clean
```

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy.
```

**Note:** Make sure your Magento account has the permission to create tables in DB. After installing, please check if the address\_cn\_data table is empty or not. If it's empty, please import the ChinaAddress/Setup/address\_cn\_data.sql file in our module zip into your DB manually.








