Installation:

-From your base Magento2 directory -> app -> code (you may have to create this directory), create Sunflowerbiz directory to your app/code directory.

-From the base Magento2 directory, upload the contents of 'CategoryPassword' directory to 'app/code' directory of your Magento installation

-Enable the module by running the following commands on the root of your Magento installation:

bin/magento module:enable --clear-static-content Sunflowerbiz_CategoryPassword bin/magento setup:upgrade

The following commands should work even in windows with the forward slash swapped for back.

php bin/magento cache:clean php bin/magento setup:upgrade php bin/magento setup:di:compile php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

Search a Password Protected Product

If you search a product from a password-protected category, the product will not display in search results.

Note: if a product belongs to multi-categories or subcategories, please set a password for all related categories or subcategories to protect it.

Session Time

This module uses the Magento system session to record a password. Within the session time, customers don't need to enter the password again.

You can set your magento system session time on admin panel-> Stores->Configuration->Advanced->Admin->Security->Admin Session Lifetime
